Proposed Federal Funding Cuts




White House budget cut proposals for NIH

What about IDC reductions or elimination?




FIGURE 2-3 Cumulative number of regulatory changes applicable to research institutions (since 1991a). SOURCE: Courtesy of the Federal of American Societies for Experimental Biology, 2015. Based upon data selected by the Council on Government Relations.

What about IDC reductions or elimination?

- In the 1990's regulation/reporting requirements increased by about 1.5/year
- 2003-2012 regulation/reporting requirements increased by 5.8/year
- FY15 Universities spent \$4.8 billion on unrecovered IDC expenses and \$1.3 billion on cost sharing
