NIH Updates – Salary Cap Increase

Effective January 8th, 2017 the NIH salary cap has increased from \$185,100 to \$187,000.

Applications

• All NIH grant applications moving forward should employ this new cost cap for all personnel with a base salary at or over \$187,000.

Awards

• All awards received with a start date on or after January 8th should employ this new cost cap for all personnel with a base salary at or over \$187,000. For awards with active periods both before and after January 8th (i.e. 11/1/16 – 10/31/2017) it is highly recommended that departments prorate salary, employing the \$185,100 cap prior to January 8th and \$187,000 cap after.

NIH Updates – Continuing Resolution


- NIH is currently operating under a Continuing Resolution (NOT-OD-17-001)
- Non-competing research grant awards will be issued at a level below that indicated on the most recent Notice of Award, generally up to 90% of the previously committed level
- Some new awards may be reduced in their initial year
- Upward adjustments to awarded levels will be considered after FY 2017 appropriations are enacted




