

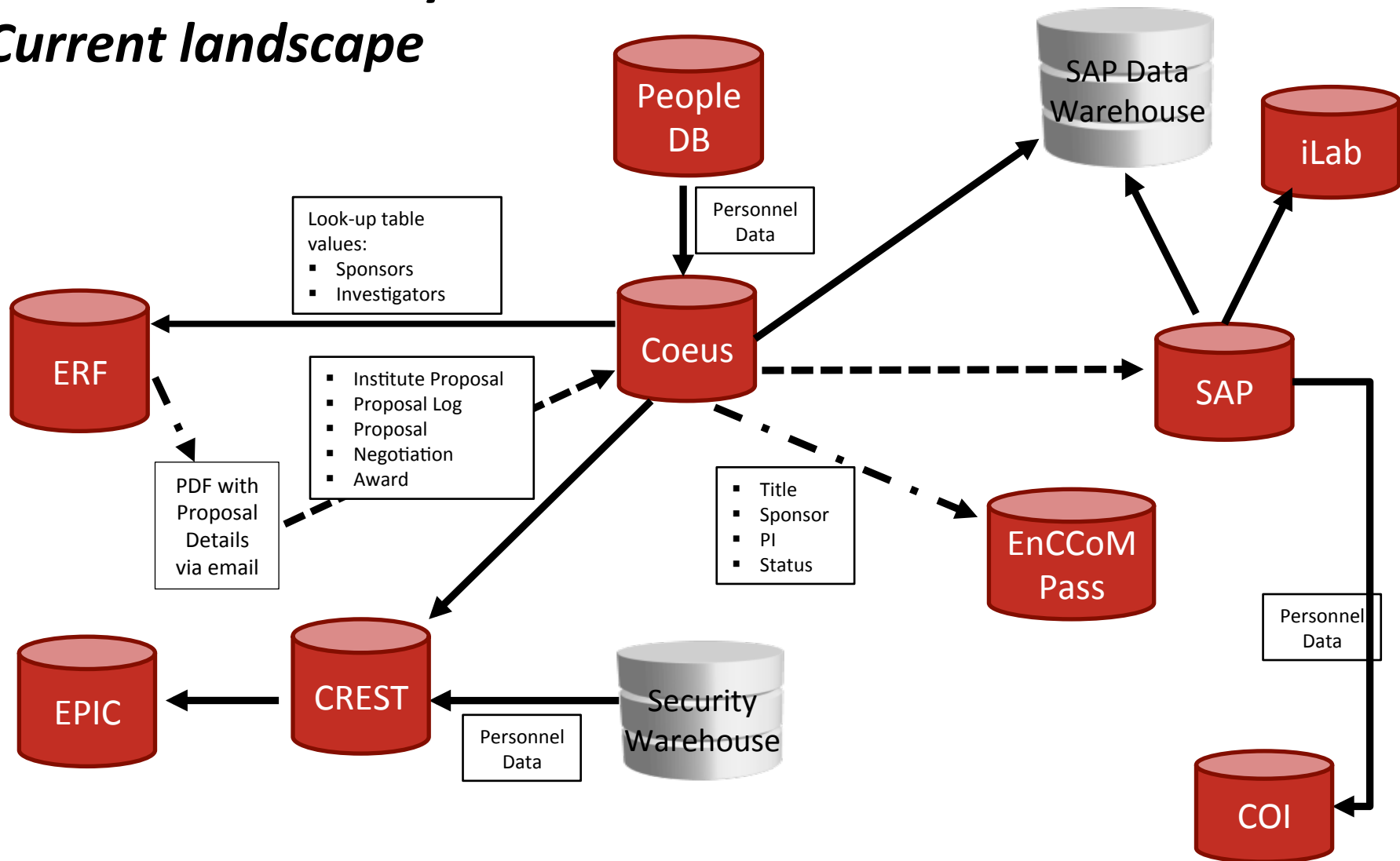

- Difficult comprehensive reporting

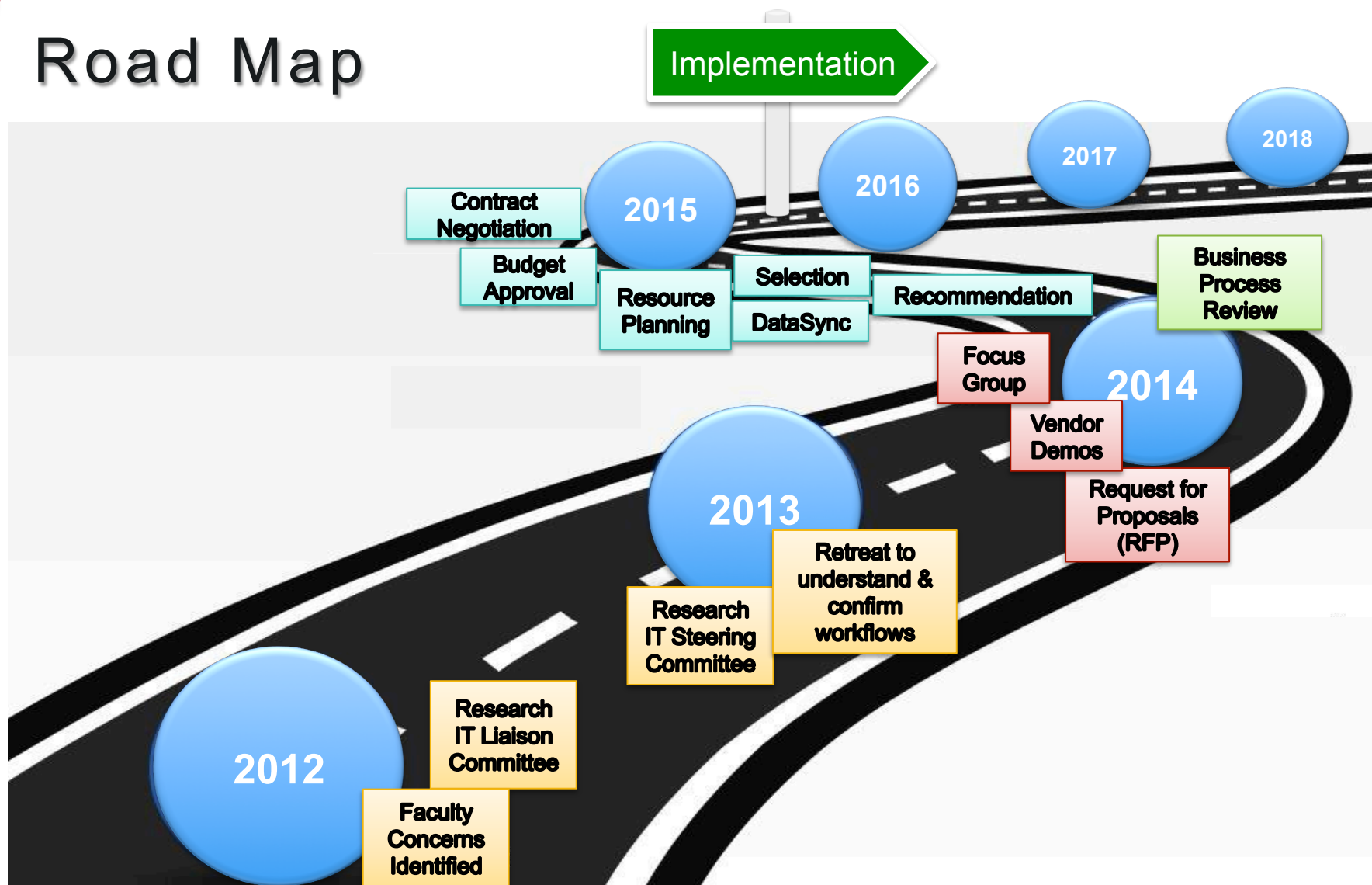


Solution Goal

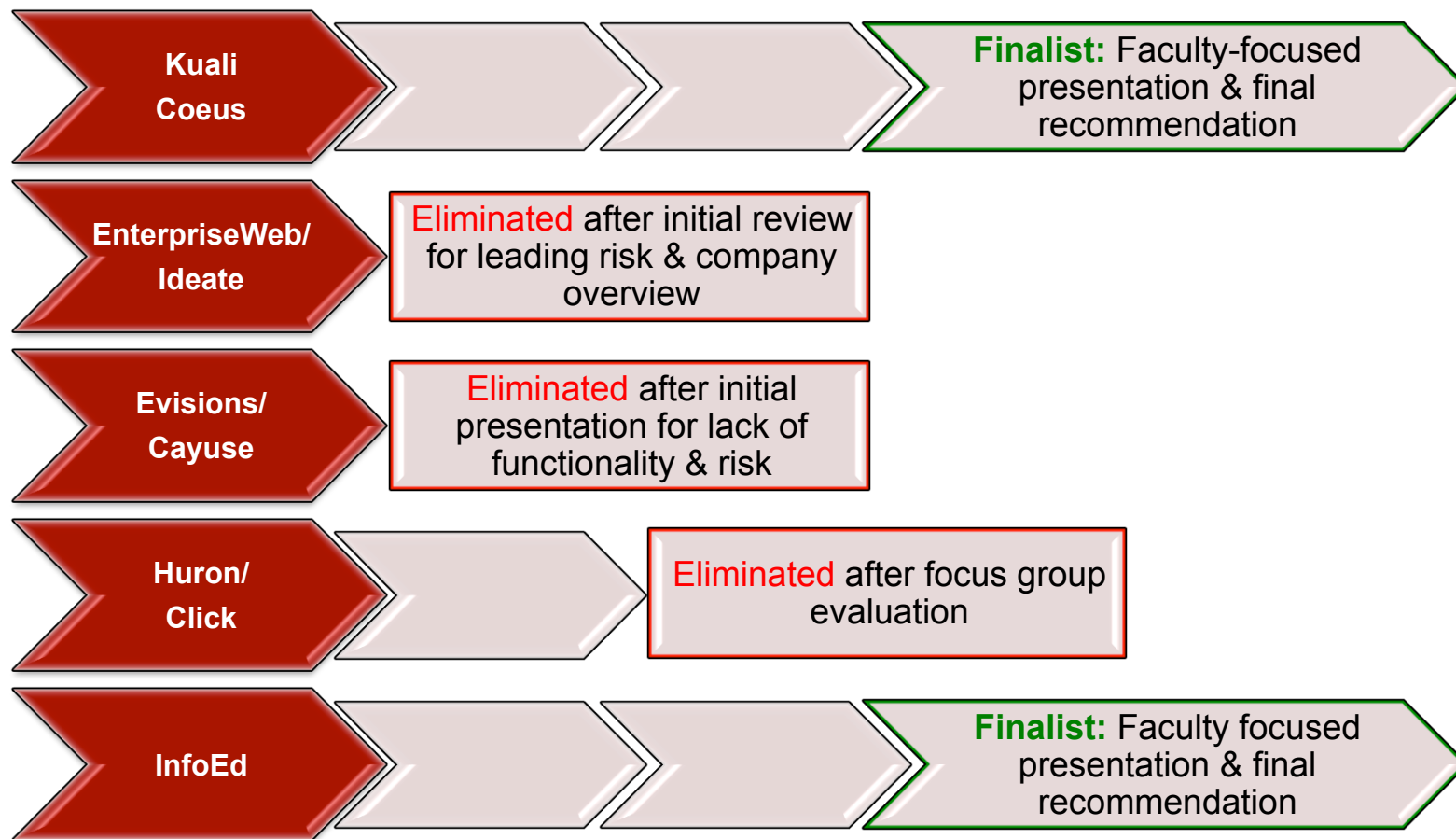

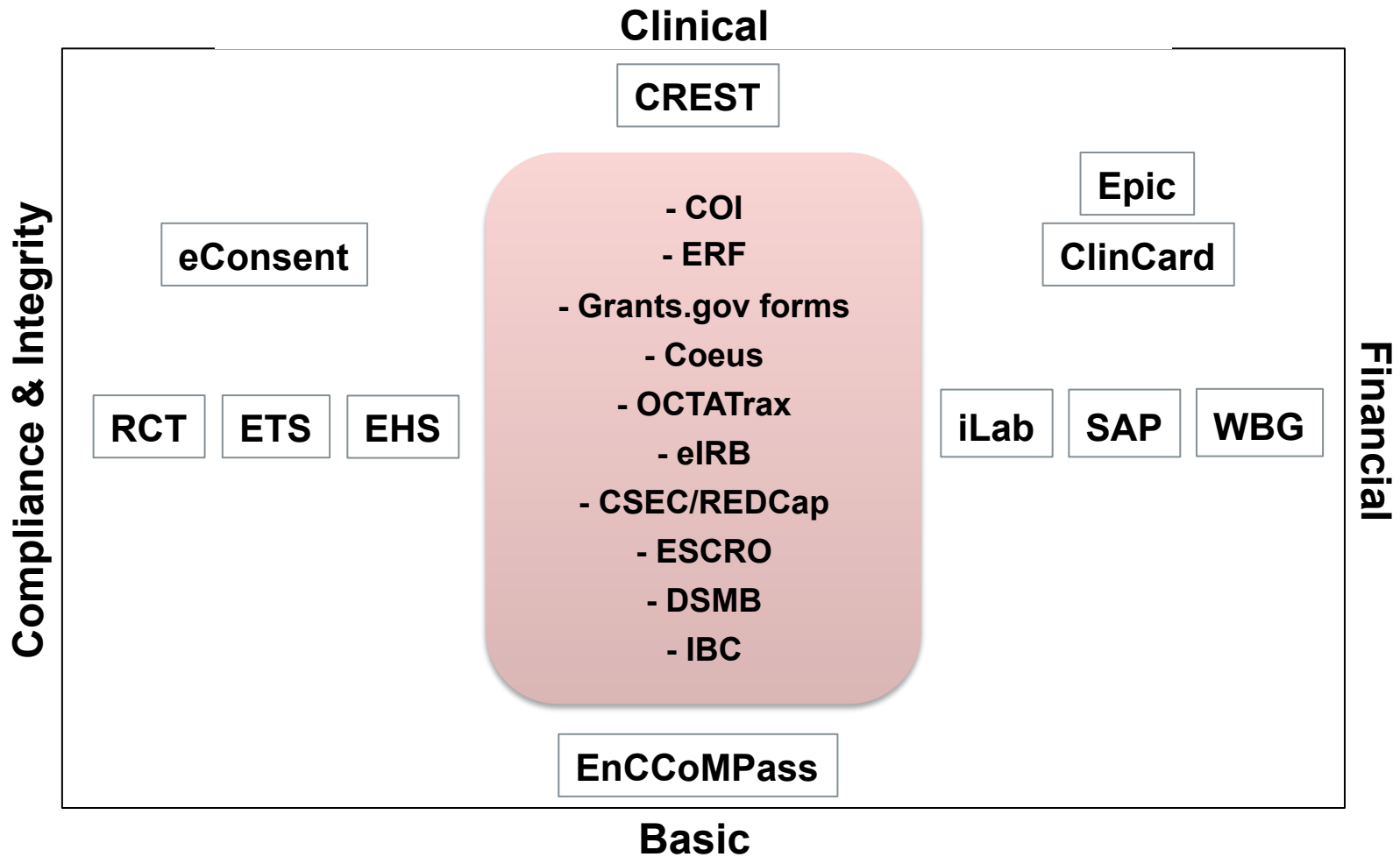


What is InfoEd?

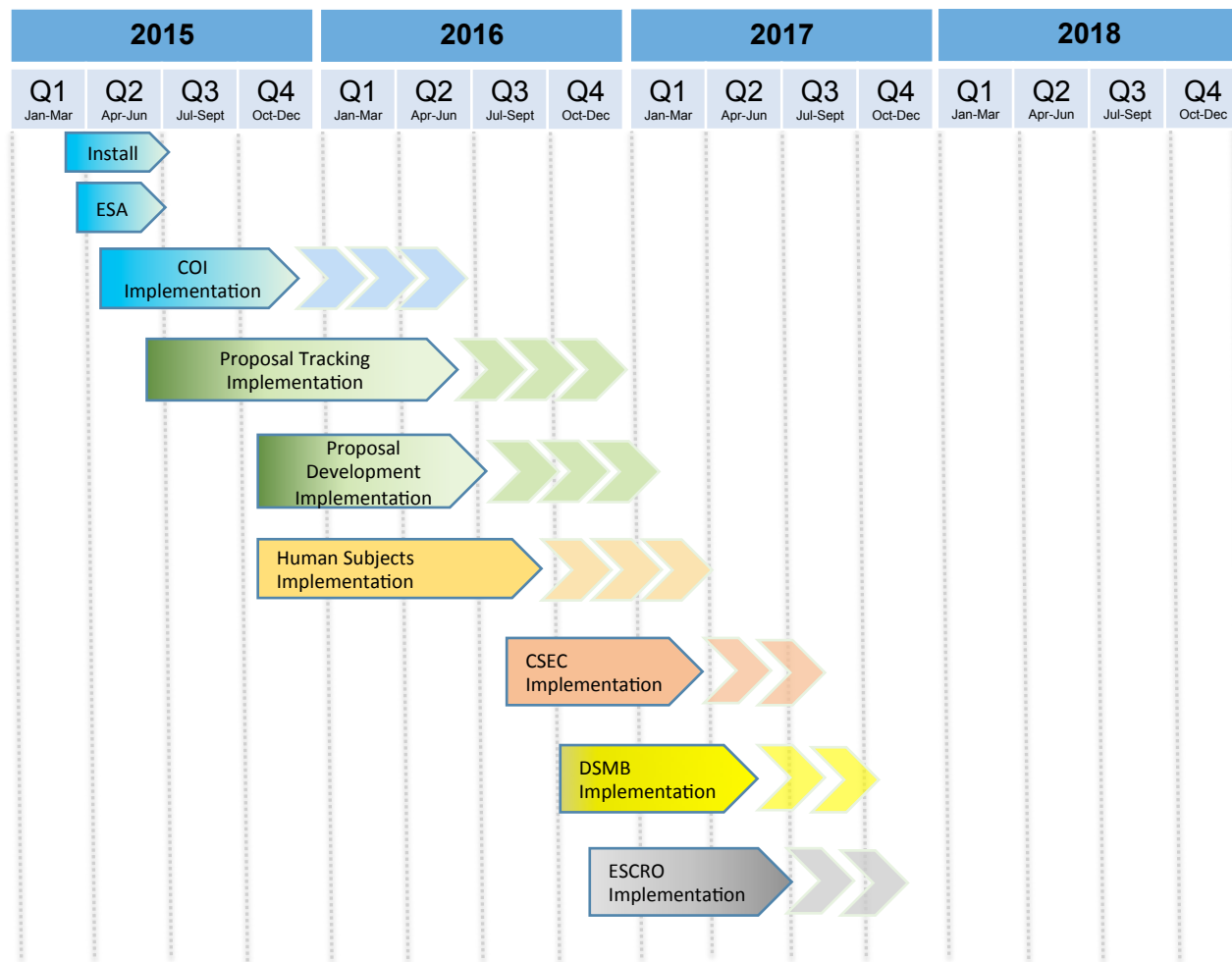
- Single vendor solution for Research Administration providing unified development and support
